

Bursary proposal agreed

Thursday 23rd August 7.45pm

This CLP proposes to support any member for the purposes of political education or engagement.

The following criteria to apply:

- 1. This is available to any paid up active full member of the CLP.
- 2. Active members considered to be regular canvassers, regular attendees of meetings, back office support (not exclusively, but in the executive's collective opinion).
- 3. The CLP will consider applications up to £500 per individual for a period spanning up to two years. Individuals may apply multiple times in any two-year period up to the maximum of £500.
- 4. The activities can range from attendance at meetings, lectures, travel if related to political education or any activity that the Executive consider worthy of support.
- 5. Applications to be made in writing to the Secretary for consideration by the Executive before any activity is commenced.
- 6. Applicants are encouraged to submit no more than 300 words in support of their application, but the executive reserve the right to request more information should this be needed.
- 7. The executive's decision is final and the decision cannot be appealed.
- 8. As there is currently no way of judging uptake, the executive will not set a cap on the number of applications, but the treasurer has final say on commitment to support depending on the CLPs net surplus funds.
- 9. This scheme can be withdrawn without notice at any time by the executive.
- 10. The CLP shall reimburse any payment after the activity has occurred subject to the above criteria being met.
