Bursary reminder



The 2019 Accounts have now been completed and need sending to HQ, the tax return has been sent to HMRC. The bank mandate needs to be transferred over to the new Treasurer and 2020 accounts to be signed off by the auditor.

We are still expecting a substantial electricity rebate and are awaiting a final ombudsman decision, it's either £2.5k or £5k, so worth pursuing!
