Conference condemns Putin's illegal invasion of Ukraine

Conference notes:

- The invasion of Ukraine is an unprovoked and unjustifiable outrage solely of Putin's making.
- The illegal invasion has resulted in senseless loss of life and brought crimes against humanity.
- The Labour Party expresses solidarity with the Ukrainian people at this difficult time and admiration for the incredible bravery they have shown in defending their country against tyranny and imperialism.

Conference resolves:

- The Labour Party should continue to stand with NATO allies in providing military, economic, diplomatic and humanitarian assistance to the Ukrainian people
- Develop a long-term strategy on energy, economics and politics to tackle Putin and dictators around the world to ensure security for British people and our partners and allies around the world
- Develop a long-term strategy to ensure British forces are equipped to keep Britain and our allies safe and secure against threats of force.
- Work closely with other European governments and other international allies to provide assistance and give refuge to Ukrainians fleeing conflict.
- Support ICC investigations into potential war crimes committed by Russian forces in Ukraine.
