#### **London Regional Conference**

Our delegates (Ana and Dan) attended the London regional Conference. Sadiq Khan spoke at the conference on the first day, the reception he received was heartwarming, he had an awful week with the offensive Islamophobic comments from the newly appointed Reform MP for Ashfield, the room was full of love for him. There was a great session that Peter Kyle MP led on innovation, the opportunities for the public sector and the exciting new jobs that investment in the sector can create. There were break out areas on topic around being a councillor, very much focused on what Labour could do, little on the frustrations of being a councillor in opposition. Let's hope we can change that in 2026! The highlight for me (Ana) was making contact with Sadiq's campaign manager Matt Greencough, he is now on speed dial. Ana asked if the campaign will be tailored to Outer London voters, as there is a concern that 'Outrage' London might be dismissed, but was assured that there will be support. Matt liked the idea of a Myth Buster campaign. Finally, Dan approved of the food, plentiful and delicious!

#### **OBS** were runner ups!

At very short notice a team of members with the support of Ana Vice Chair (Membership & Campaigns) stepped up at the request of the National Party to join their 'Fire Drill'. Members were posting about 3 topics intensely (not Labour branded). NHS, sewage and the cost of living, reaching thousands of local voters on the NextDoor Platform and Facebook local groups. Some of our 'cohort' had never posted before and found their content very well received.

All this activity was put on a league table and in the ACTIVE POWERHOUSE section we were the runner up with 8 participants, compared to the winners with 9. 69 CLPS took part across the country, so this is an amazing achievement. Well done to our team.

#### **OBS** canvass sessions


## **Women's Group Event**
